
THE TEAM

All the team members are chosen based on their experience with children, their age and their training. They are all bilingual.

The staff quota is above the current regulations in France. We have 1 adult for 6 children maximum.

Our team is experienced, qualified and competent and entirely devoted to the personal development of each child. The adults are all enthusiastic and capable of motivating and adapting to the young people. They accompany the children during each activity or excursion and act as role-models and guides for the campers. Natural leadership and organizational skills, a good sense of humor and an understanding of the needs of the group create a good team, with a number of counselors coming back year after year. Our Director, the language teachers and the counselors are undoubtably the main factors in creating an unforgettable vacation for your children!



SAFETY AND SECURITY

Security is an essential part of our camps:

the children are supervised 24 hours a day. Megève provides a peaceful place and a safe environment. All the service providers are qualified in their relevant activities (mountain guide, ski instructor ...). Our responsibility is very important to us and we perfectly understand the concerns of each parent when their child is away from home. We take every precaution to ensure the health and safety of our participants. We will, of course, make sure the children take their medicines as necessary.

We are proud of our strengths in hospitality and security/supervision.

We deliberately limit the capacity of our camps to 50 children. This allows us to create a multicultural atmosphere and to look after the wellbeing of each participant.

AN ATTRACTIVE DESTINATION

Our summer and winter camps take place in <u>Megève</u>, a <u>French ski resort with an international reputation</u>.

Megève is located in the heart of the Savoy Alps, close to Switzerland and Italy. Located in a preserved mountain environment at 1113 meters, Megève is a village with a delicate charm. Megève combines the magic and elegance of a winter and summer sports resort with a real Savoy village, rich in its history and its people. In the summer, Megève invites you to enjoy walks, mountain biking and horse riding, along with water and air sports.

Perfectly equipped with a sports infrastructure, Megève offers a wide choice of activities linked to the mountains and comes to life in the summer with a large classical music festival and a jazz competition which everyone can enjoy. There are wonderful nature walks and you can make all kinds of discoveries by following paths, animal tracks, or the clouds.

The village is ideal for vacations in the open-air!

The ski resort of Megève is in the Alps, close to Switzerland and Italy.











OUR LANGUAGE LESSONS

Our morning English and French language lessons are based on the programs designed for the University of Cambridge and Alliance Française examinations and are adapted to the different levels of the students.

Our teachers:

All of our teachers are qualified and experienced in teaching young people; the teachers are all native speakers. Their motivation is behind the specific character of our program and guarantees its success. They prepare their program according to a theme which changes every year.

Have fun learning:

Our aim is to teach languages to children so that they can progress and the students enrich their vocabulary while enjoying learning. As we want our lessons to be lively and different from typical school lessons, the classes are limited to a maximum of eight participants per class. This and the fact that the classes are based on the level of the children, allow greater participation and improvement.

Adapted to your level:

We focus on conversation and gaining confidence. Classes are available for beginners, intermediates or advanced students. Lessons are based on the direct method and require the active participation of the student. Teachers work exclusively in their native language.

During the summer camps, to use their linguistic knowledge, the campers produce a play assisted by the teachers and counselors. Each child can give their best performance by having fun.

Depending on the program chosen, there are 5 hours (Teens Moutain and Water Sports) or 15 hours (Kids and Junior) of language instruction each week.

ACCOMMODATIONS AND MEALS

The quality of the accommodations:

At Jeunes Diplomates we consider the quality of the accommodations to be an essential condition for the well being of our campers, and therefore our programs are organized solely in top quality hotels.

The children appreciate their stay in one of the double rooms (2 to 4 people) decorated in the Alpine style synonymous with calm, comfort and relaxation.

We are the only camp organizers in France to propose accommodations of this quality.

Children are allocated their rooms depending on the following criteria: same sex, same age group, different native languages.

As safety and security are of top importance in our camps, the counselors' rooms are situated close to the children's rooms, on the same floor.

We are very conscious of allowing the campers time to rest, depending on their needs. Bedtime varies, therefore, depending on their age and the activities planned in the program.

To maintain an organization at a comfortable level, we deliberately limit capacity to 50 children. This allows us to create a multicultural dynamic and to look after the well being of each of our participants.

The meals:

Children have their lunch in a restaurant near the school and dinner in the restaurant of the hotel. The menus are prepared by the chefs who takes into account a balanced diet and the tastes of the children.

We can organize special menus (vegetarian, gluten-free etc); we just need to be advised in advance.

The school:

The language lessons and the creative and artistic workshops are held in a school in Megève close to the hotel. We are therefore able to use all of the established infrastructure (classrooms, sports facilities...).

Day camp

If you already have accommodations in or around Megève, the "Day Camp" formula is perfect for you. Every day from 9am to 6pm, you can follow the daily program including the language lessons, lunch and the activities.

Please note that in this case the daily transport to and from the school is not organized by Jeunes Diplomates.

What happens after?

After receipt of the deposit, if we are able to accept your child, we will send you the following documents:

- The medical questionnaire (to be returned by mail, fax or email before the start of the camp)
- The arrival / departure form (to be returned by mail, fax or email before the start of the camp)
- A welcome letter and the camp handbook

Documents to be returned:

Enrollment form, medical questionnaire, arrival / departure form

The forms should be completed and sent to the camp <u>at least 3 weeks before the arrival of the camper</u>.

Enrollments will not be confirmed until receipt of the signed enrollment form and the deposit of 500 euros per child per session depending on the availability of places.

Conditions of Acceptance

Each participant agrees, in writing, to respect the rules of the camp and to behave in a manner suitable to Camp life.

The Camp Director reserves the right to dismiss any child, without refund, whose behavior is not, in his opinion, compatible with the smooth running of the organization. Any charges incurred to send the child home will be at the expense of the parents.

Practical information

All amounts are due in Euros; for payments made in other currencies the conversion will be made using the daily rate. Any difference will be credited, or additional payment requested.

Acceptance of your child will be confirmed upon receipt of the total amount due.

As the number of places is limited, we advise parents to enroll as early as possible. This is particularly recommended for the first sessions which full-up rapidly.

GENERAL SALES CONDITIONS

1. Payment terms:

For applications from November to March: balance payable before

For applications from April to June: payment in full is required. If these requirements are not met, your application may be cancelled.

The price of the camp includes the following:

- half-board or full-board in a 3* hotel depending on the formula
- the organization and control of the activities by the Camp staff
- the enrollment fees
- the language lessons (5 hours per week for the Teen programs and 15 hours per week for the Kids and Junior programs)
- all sporting and cultural activities
- laundry service (once a week for those staying longer than 7 days)
- a camp T-shirt
- a USB stick with the camp photos

The price of the camp does not include:

- transfer to/from Geneva airport (230 euros per transfer)
- travel expenses to the camp
- personal expenses, illness or accident insurance (proof of insurance is required), any medical expenses.

2. Conditions of Cancellation

It is highly recommended that you take out cancellation insurance in your home country in order to be fully reimbursed in case of cancellation before the start of the camp, or before the planned departure date (for example for illness, accident, family problems....) The enrollment fees of 50 euros are non-refundable and nontransferable.

In case of cancellation you will be charged as follows:

- 5% of the total cost of the camp if we are notified of your cancellation by registered letter more than 60 days before the start of the camp.
- 25% of the total amount under the same conditions between 60 and 30 days before the start of the camp.
- 100% of the total amount for notification less than 30 days before the start of the camp.

There is no refund for any stay which is shortened (even in the case of force majeure). The above fees for cancellation or shortened stay compensate for our financial loss due to charges already incurred on your child's behalf. All cancellations or shortened stays must be notified by registered mail with acknowledgment of receipt.

In the case of cancellation by Jeunes Diplomates: the company will inform you immediately and the total amount of the fund transferred will be reimbursed without other indemnity.

In case of dispute, the place of jurisdiction will be the Court of Annecy which applies French law.

3. Insurance

Our company, our team and the participants are covered in case of:

- accident, civil responsibility
- defense and assistance.
- personal effects of minors are not covered (send clothing which is not expensive and not easily soiled).
- Repatriation of minors is not covered. We recommend you take out repatriation insurance.

Loss and Theft: There is no coverage in case of theft; all valuables should be given to the Camp Director.

It is each parent's responsibility to ensure that their child has all relevant travel and health documents. Please check visa requirements.

4. Image rights

During camp, photographs will be taken which may be used for publicity purposes. Please advise us in writing if you do not wish us to use your child's image.

5. Dismissal

If your child does not adapt to the camp or does not respect the rules, your child may be sent home. You will be personally advised and all repatriation fees including any fees incurred by persons accompanying them will be at your expense. No refund will be made.

Smoking and the consumption of alcohol by campers is strictly forbidden.

Departure and Return

• With accommodations:

Participants should arrive on Sunday at 5pm at the hotel. Campers leave at 6 pm on the last Saturday of their session.

Without accommodations:

Participants should meet us on Sunday at 5pm in front of the hotel. Every morning campers should be at the school at 8.45am. Parents/guardians can collect them every evening at 6pm at the same location.

When the children arrive and leave, the presence of an adult at the meeting place is obligatory. If it is not the parent or the legal guardian of the child, a signed authorization is required stating the name and address of the person coming to meet the child.

For other departures, a written authorization from the parent/guardian is required indicating the specifics of the return journey along with the person accompanying the child. No child will be allowed to depart without an adult accompanying them.

If a child is required to leave the camp early for any reason, the departure will take place the following day after breakfast with one of the parents or the legal guardian.

<u>Arrivals and Departures by Air:</u>

On arrival and departure days, a camp representative is available to accompany the campers to and from Geneva airport (transfer fee 220 euros per transfer). At their departure, the children will be assisted with check-in and customs formalities. If they are travelling as a UM (unaccompanied minor), they will be escorted to the plane. For organizational purposes, information concerning the arrival and departure of the participants must be confirmed in writing at least two weeks before the date of the journey. Individual arrangements and last minute changes will be invoiced accordingly.

7. Medical Expenses

During the camp, Jeunes Diplomates will advance the costs for the following medical fees:


- Transport and visit to the doctor
- Medicine.

At the end of the stay, the parents must reimburse these costs. In case of illness, visit to the doctor or accident, you will be advised by the Camp Director as soon as possible. No medication can be taken without prescription during camp.

8. Responsibility

The camper and his/her parents or legal guardians are informed and accept that certain sports and activities (notably rafting and the adventure park in the trees) as well as the transportation (motor vehicles, train, ski lifts, boats etc) are undertaken by third parties who are acting in their own names and under their own responsibility.

The parent or legal guardian confirms by signature that they accept that their child participates in the sports and leisure activities organized during the camp. They understand and accept the inherent risks of these activities.



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
